## Crisis Intervention & Housing Services: 4,524 Survivors Served



**1,351** new, unduplicated individuals served

**99%** of victims had a safety plan in place after interaction with an advocate

Since basing a YWCA advocate at SLMPD (2022), sexual assault reporting at the station has increased by **550%**



**98%** of victims received accurate information about the medical system and support services that helped them make informed decisions and choices

**97%** of victims received accurate information about the legal system that helped them make informed decisions and choices

### Sexual Violence

**492** SART (Sexual Assault Response Team) requests

**482** clients received direct services  
(11% increase over 2024)

**100%** of clients developed coping, stress management and resiliency skills through therapy

**100%** of clients acquired increased knowledge of community resources

**250** St. Louis Metropolitan Police Officers voluntarily trained to work with sexual/domestic violence survivors

### Domestic Violence

**1,658** total clients served

**2,002** calls made to our 24/7 Crisis Help Line

**100%** of clients reported increased knowledge about community resources

**59** safe households created - an increase of 51% over 2024

### Housing Services

**8** clients received emergency rent and utility assistance to prevent homelessness

**142** individuals served

**64** adults

**78** children

**96%** of clients remained in or transitioned to safe housing
